Board Meeting Summary

The Board of Directors met Friday, June 1, 2018, and welcomed the newly elected members. The Board also elected, by unanimous vote, the Board officers: Bill Taylor, President; Terri Feldmayer, Vice President; Michelle Blandburg, Treasurer; Rita Way, Secretary. As president, Bill would like to start his term by focusing on updating OLLI's strategic and operating policies and making sure they are carried out. We need the vision to anticipate problems going forward and meet these challenges.

Executive Director Jennifer Disano reported that as of May 25, 2018, total membership is 1,183 (annual membership is 1,136 and term membership is 47). Mason facilities staff completed trimming trees and all other maintenance at Tallwood. On May 24 the OLLI Board served lunch to the maintenance facilities crews to thank them for taking such great

care of our facilities and maintenance needs. Jennifer announced she was elected the Chairperson of the Board of Directors of the Fall for the Book Festival at Mason for 2018-2019. She also represented OLLI at the Fairfax County Retiree Fair, the Fairfax County 50+Expo, and the Mason retiree symposium.

Under new business, the Board opposed a resolution that the Board direct changes to the Board Handbook: Section X, Attachment H. Procedures and Guideline for the Nominating Committee concerning scheduling of the June Board meeting for the regular 3rd Friday of the month. The Board also opposed a resolution that the Board direct establishment of an ad hoc committee to investigate improvements in accessibility to the Tallwood campus and make recommendations for appropriate expenditures, opting instead to invite the chair of the Facilities Committee to consider the issue. A resolution that the OLLI Board of Directors be reduced from 18 to 17 was opposed.
